

# KIDS for BACH

The Boulder Bach Festival again presents an opportunity for children to perform Bach in free public concerts in the Canyon Theater at the Boulder Public Library

**WHO** – Participants must be no older than 18 on February 7, 2010, and must live or study in Boulder or Broomfield Counties. We invite and encourage students of all levels and all instruments, including voice, to participate in these recorded auditions. Duets, trios, and larger groups (no more than 24) are also welcome and encouraged to submit audition materials.

**REPERTOIRE** – The piece performed must be a work of J.S. Bach or one of his sons. Most pieces should be in the range of 1-2 minutes, although a few longer selections of 3-4 minutes will be considered in the more advanced repertoire. Students selected to play will perform their submitted audition piece at the Library concert. Only one piece per student or ensemble may be submitted.

**FEE** – Include an application fee of \$10 with each entry. Please make checks out to **Boulder Bach Festival** and consolidate fees into one check for multiple entries from the same teacher or family.

**AUDITION TAPES/CDs** – Please submit an audio cassette tape or CD. Insert the completed application blank (see below) into the cassette or CD case. Label the cassette/CD itself with the student's name and instrument. Please be as specific as possible in listing the title of the piece, for example, not "Minuet in D" but "Minuet from Suite No. 2 in D Major, BWV 1008." Include BWV number.

**DEADLINE** – Tapes/CDs will be accepted from now until December 21, 2009. Put the cassette or CD (in its case with the application blank) into an envelope with the fee. **DO NOT** put the fee into the cassette or CD case. Entries **must be postmarked by December 21, 2009**, and mailed to Charlotte Corbridge, 7351 Windsor Drive, Boulder, 80301. Tapes or CDs may be picked up after the concert on February 7, 2010.
